## The Next Leg

Bentley, 1929 Le Mans

The painting depicts Frank Clements jumping into 'number 8' to take on the next leg of this famous race. He took Bentley's first victory in the 1922 Tourist Trophy race on the Isle of Man and won Le Mans in 1924 with John Duff. The 1929 Le Mans race itself was little more than a winning procession for Bentley; they took first, second, third and fourth place.
